




## Declaration of Conformity to the EU Directive 1907/2006 (REACH)


The new European Chemicals Act REACH became effective on June 1st, 2007. REACH is a standardized system for registration, evaluation and authorization of chemicals. Its aim is to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment. Therefore any substances which are produced in the EU or have been imported into the EU have to be (pre-) registered at ECHA, Helsinki. We at Craemer as a downstream user of raw materials consider it is our responsibility to request a (extended) material safety data sheet from our suppliers and to conform to its risk management measures.

Any of our suppliers is asked by our delivery conditions to register any substance which is contained in their products as required by REACH or to contract their pre-suppliers.

Hereby we certify to be compliant to REACH referring purchase and handling of raw materials, furthermore we would like to point out the abidance by any relevant legal regulation.

This conformity includes those 14 substances, which are added by the ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) to the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) in January 2010.
